

Water Park Camp Rules

1. Camp counselors are responsible for their campers safety at all times
2. Lifeguards are here to enforce rules and respond to emergencies
3. No swimming in heavy rain or lightning
4. No breath holding games or exercises allowed
5. No Diving allowed anywhere inside the facility
6. No head first sliding (feet first only)
7. No running, horse play or towel snapping
8. No floats, fins, diving masks or water toys/equipment allowed
9. Shower before entering pools
10. No playing in showers
11. Proper swimming attire required, no cut off or jean materials
12. Children under the age of (3) or un-potty trained must wear disposable swim pants
13. No smoking
14. No gum chewing
15. No animals or pets
16. No towels or clothes hanged on fence
17. Do not block Breeze Way
18. No climbing or swinging on pipes or hand rails
19. Patrons with wounds, open sores, skin infections will be excluded from water activities
20. The City of Miami it is not responsible for lost or stolen items
21. No rain checks or refunds
22. No reentry, patrons who leave the facility must pay to reenter
23. Facility administrators have the right to close the facility for the safety of the patrons
24. If facility closes due to inclement weather, the camp must leave the facility immediately
25. A buddy system or other means of organization should be arranged in advance and strictly enforced during any activity
26. No outside food or drinks allowed in the facility
27. No foods or drinks allowed in water areas
28. All campers must be keep HYDRATED throughout the day
29. Camps must leave facility at their designated times
30. Camps must leave their areas clean, food and drinks must be placed inside the garbage containers
31. Management reserves the right to refuse service or expel any patron with just cause.
